

AMCOR Scholarship

Introduction

AMCOR and the Trinity College Foundation have combined to establish a two year Scholarship to encourage and directly assist a past Trinity College student, currently undertaking an Engineering Degree, to complete their studies. AMCOR and the Foundation offer this Scholarship annually to a student entering either their 3rd year of a single degree or 4th year of a double degree.

Criteria

Subject to satisfactory progress, as determined by the selection committee, the scholarship shall be tenable for up to 2 years by a student enrolled full-time in Electrical, Mechanical, Mechatronics or Chemical Engineering single or double degrees.

Applicants for the scholarship will be chosen on the basis of their aptitude for / application of engineering principles, leadership qualities, abilities in lateral thinking, academic achievement and AMCOR Glass key values.

Applications will be reviewed initially by the Head of Trinity College Gawler, the Human Resources Manager of AMCOR and the Chair of Trinity College Foundation.

Process

Applications **must be received** by **30 March 2012**.

Short listed applicants will be notified and asked to prepare a presentation for the interview panel which comprises of the Head of Trinity College, Year 12 coordinator, SACE Coordinator and up to two nominees of AMCOR Glass.

The scholarship will be awarded at the discretion of the Head of Trinity College in conjunction with an AMCOR representative. No award shall be made if, in the opinion of the Head, no candidate is of sufficient merit.

Award

The Scholarship will entitle the successful applicant to \$5,000 over two years and work experience at AMCOR Glass.

The successful application will be offered either part time or vacation full time paid employment at times to be agreed by AMCOR and the awardee.

The first instalment of \$2,000 towards university fees will be paid when the student commences their 3rd or 4th year of the program of study for the degree of Bachelor of Engineering in Electrical, Mechanical, Mechatronics or Chemical Engineering. The second instalment of \$3,000 shall be paid when the student commences their 4th or 5th year.

Expectations

The successful applicants will be asked to speak at a Foundation meeting or gathering as a scholarship recipient. The successful applicants will be photographed and acknowledged in the College publications and on the website.
