The Colin & Alexandra Hamilton Scholarships

Introduction

The Colin & Alexandra Hamilton Scholarships are funded by a very generous bequest to the College by Mr & Mrs Colin Hamilton. The scholarships seek to offer places to students who will contribute to the richness and diversity of the College's community.

Criteria

Applicants must be in Year 7 at the time of application.

The scholarship is awarded to students whose financial circumstances mean they would find it difficult to attend or complete their secondary education at Trinity College.

Process

Applications **must be received** by **31 March** each year.

Short listed applicants will be notified and asked to meet with the Head of Trinity College for an interview. All applications are handled confidentially due to the sensitive nature of financial circumstances that are involved for the applicants.

Data supporting financial need is to be supplied with the application to the Finance Director of the College. The scholarships will be awarded at the discretion of the Head of Trinity College. No award shall be made if, in the opinion of the Head, no candidate is of sufficient merit.

Award

The scholarship will entitle the successful applicants to a 50% discount on tuition fees from Years 8 to 12. Two scholarships are awarded per annum. One is for an internal student and the second for an external student.

An annual review of the successful recipient will occur in December each year so that satisfactory progress is maintained.

Expectations

Due to the sensitive nature of financial records provided with this application, the successful applicant's names will not be announced nor published to the wider community, nor any Certificate of recognition sent.
