Subject: Private Communication Network

Dear Parents,

You may have noticed poles going up at Blakeview, Gawler River and South. These poles are part of the new Private Communication Network the College is installing.

This network replaces the current wireless network that connects Blakeview and Gawler River to Gawler and which has provided internet access and communication to these two schools. The new Private Communication Network is microwave based and each pole will have two microwave dishes at the top pointing at each of the other poles. These dishes send out a narrow microwave beam along which computer based communications occur. This new Private Communication Network will offer substantial Information Technology benefits to Blakeview and Gawler River, both students and staff will enjoy much improved IT performance.

This Private Communication Network has been the subject of a significant Council approval process, in both Playford and Gawler, which has considered all aspects especially including safety. The microwave beam is narrow and low energy and not at all dangerous. The College would not have considered this project if there was any risk to members of our community or to our neighbours.
